- Officers as Heavy Cavalry. The most senior Officer may be depicted as Heavy Infantry.
- Early Samurai may field an Army Standard mounted on the base of the most senior Officer fielded. If Warrior Monks are fielded, then a Sacred Standard may also be fielded, mounted on its own base, as a portable shrine carried by Warrior Monks.
- Up to a quarter of all samurai bases fielded may be upgraded to Elite at a cost of +4 points per base.
- Mounted Samurai are classed as 2H for consistency and because a proportion may also be armed with PO, providing an effect equivalent to 2H used on foot.
- Any Foot Samurai may be rearmed with PO for –2 points per base.
- Retainer bases may be upweighted to front rank HI at a cost of +2 points per base.
- Foot armed with LB or BO may be given ½SH in the form of ground-standing pavises at a cost of +1 points per base.
- Longbows used by mounted troops count as Longbows but with the range of Mounted Bows.
